  - City of Medford put up a No Camping Sign with violation code reference
  - Safety is the main concern and due to issues in the past, activity that is not deemed to be in the best interest of the group will be reported immediately to MPD and ask them to remove the individual.
  - Homeless people are NOT being targeted. It's a conduct issue.
    - Each Secretary is tasked with removal of people disturbing the meeting, but some are uncomfortable contacting the police. This will make it easier for contact.
