Item: Laurie proposes we no longer hold votes on every report. Instead, she suggests we vote to approve/correct minutes and treasurer's report only. Votes would still be taken on business items. Passed unanimously.

Item: Meeting schedule changes: Sat. 4 pm mtg on schedule no longer exists; Sun, 8 pm mtg does exist and is not yet on schedule. Kathleen signed onto Central Office website and made these corrections during meeting. Awesome, Kathleen!!!!

Item: Laurie proposes we no longer ask biz mtg attendees to contribute to 7^{th} tradition. Attendees donate time and often supplies to support fellowship and Laurie says she finds it slightly offensive that attendees are also asked to participate in 7^{th} tradition. Vote is 8-1 in favor of eliminating 7^{th} tradition.

In keeping with traditions, Laurie invited Leanne to explain her no vote. As holder of the minority opinion, Laurie explained, Leanne is entitled to discuss her reasoning. Leanne explained that fellowship needs "every dollar it can get," and pointed out that no one is forced to donate. Her arguments convinced attendees to change votes, and they voted unanimously to continue 7^{th} tradition after all. Laurie says this is another great example of how traditions regarding consensus and minority opinions work.
